

Summary: An ordinance amending Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the City Code of the City of Ely requiring the City Council to create a code of conduct for its members to apply during city council meetings and interactions with city personnel, to include following the chain of command.; ~~proscribing that violation of the Code of Conduct constitutes cause within the meaning of NRS 266.240.~~

TITLE:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 1 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ELY REQUIRING THE CITY COUNCIL TO CREATE A CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ITS MEMBERS TO APPLY DURING CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND INTERACTIONS WITH CITY PERSONNEL, TO INCLUDE FOLLOWING THE CHAIN OF COMMAND.; ~~PROSCRIBING THAT VIOLATION OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT CONSTITUTES CAUSE WITHIN THE MEANING OF NRS 266.240.~~

Whereas, NRS 266.240 provides that the City Council shall determine its own rules of procedure, may punish its members for disorderly conduct, and, with the concurrence of two-thirds of the members of the city council, may expel a member for cause;

Whereas, NRS 266.200 provides that the Mayor of the City of Ely shall preserve order and decorum among the members of the City Council and enforce the rules of the City Council;

Therefore, the City Council of the City of Ely, State of Nevada, does AMEND and otherwise ordain that the sections of Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the City Code of the City of Ely specified below shall read as follows:

1-5-7: CONDUCT OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

The City Council shall adopt a Code of Conduct for its members to apply during city council meetings and interactions with city personnel, to include following the chain of command.

1-5-~~87~~: SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS:

A. Mayor: The salary of the mayor shall be set at six hundred dollars (\$600.00) per month.

B. Councilmen: The salaries of each respective city council member shall be set at five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per month. (Ord. 518, 6-12-1997)

2-5-~~913~~: SEVERABILITY:

If any provisions of this Ordinance are held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and each provision is hereby declared to be severable.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after passage, approval, and publication.
