RESOLUTION No. 2017-16

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH BUSINESS FEE STRUCTURE FOR MEDICAL MARIJUANA FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Ely City Council finds:

(1) In 2013 the Nevada Legislature passed, and the Governor signed into law, Senate Bill 374, now codified in NRS 453A, which allows medical marijuana establishments within the state of Nevada; and requires such establishments to comply with all local business licensing requirements and local land use and code requirements;

(2) Federal law and related regulations classify marijuana as a Schedule I controlled substance and prohibit its cultivation, possession, dispensing and use, among other things, for medical reasons or otherwise. This Resolution is intended to set the fees allowed pursuant to Chapter 453A and supplement the Ordinance which implements NRS 453A and establishes the criteria for the issuance of licenses that are a prerequisite for the exemption from state prosecution provided for in NRS 453A;

(3) The public health, safety and welfare require that medical marijuana facilities and their employees be regulated and licensed in order to protect the public.

B. The City Council declares that this Resolution setting fees is an exercise of the regulatory powers delegated to the City Council pursuant to NRS 268. The cultivation, distribution, production and sale of medical marijuana is not a matter of right but of privilege, which would otherwise be unlawful if it were not conducted pursuant to NRS 453A and a license under Title 3 Chapter 14 of the City Codes. Businesses engaged in the sale or other disposition of medical marijuana must therefore comply with all requirements of this Chapter, Nevada Revised Statutes, including, but not limited to Chapter 453A, and Nevada Administrative Code, including, but not limited to Chapter 453A. Every person licensed pursuant to Title 3 Chapter 14 shall be required to pay for the privilege of operating or working in a medical marijuana facility.

C. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed to confer any legitimate claim of entitlement to any benefit which might otherwise devolve upon any licensee or any person approved for suitability.

D. Nothing in this Chapter is intended to authorize or make legal any act that federal or state law does not permit or sanction or assist in any violation of any federal or state law. This Chapter is intended to implement NRS 453A and to establish criteria for the issuance of licenses that are a prerequisite for the exemption from state prosecution provided for in NRS 453A, and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 707 requires the City to establish the rates to be charged to businesses to be set by Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the Foregoing premises,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Effective December 1, 2017 the City of Ely is establishing the following licensing fees to be charged to businesses licensed by the State and the City of Ely for the dispensing of medical marijuana within the incorporated City limits:

A. Annual License Fee:

1. Each annual fee is due in advance on the first day of the month in which their license was issued by the City each year. License fees paid pursuant to this Chapter are not refundable.

2. Any annual fee which is not received by the City on or before the due date shall be assessed a late-payment penalty amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the amount of such annual fee.

3. If the annual fee and penalty is not received by the City within thirty (30) calendar days after the due date, an additional penalty in an amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of such annual fee shall be assessed.

4. If the annual fee and all penalties are not received by the City within sixty (60) calendar days after the due date, the license shall be automatically suspended and if the annual fee and all penalties are not received by the City within ninety (90) calendar days after the due date, the license shall be automatically revoked.

5. Each licensee shall pay to the City in advance, the annual fees set forth in the following schedule:

License Category	Annual License Fee (Dollars)
A one-time, nonrefundable application fee due at time of application for any of the licenses identified below	\$5,000.00
For the initial issuance of a business license for a medical marijuana dispensary	\$30,000.00
For the renewal of a business license for a medical marijuana dispensary	\$5,000.00
For the initial and annual issuance of a business license for a cultivation facility	\$3,000.00
For the initial and annual issuance of a medical marijuana establishment business license for a facility for the production of edible marijuana products or marijuana-infused products	\$3,000.00
For the initial and annual issuance of a business license for an independent testing laboratory	\$5,000.00

B. Semi-Annual Gross Revenue Fee:

1. Gross revenue fees shall be calculated by taking the total amount of gross sales in each license category, excluding medical marijuana dispensary sales. The licensee for all license categories, except a medical marijuana dispensary, shall remit to the City the sum equal to seven and one half percent (7.5%) of the gross revenues for each six (6) month period.

2. If the semi-annual fee and all penalties are not received by the City within sixty (60) calendar days after the due date, the license shall be automatically revoked.

3. Sales at the medical marijuana dispensary, other than medical marijuana, shall be calculated at seven and one half percent of gross sales.

C. The City reserves the right to utilize the fees in this Resolution to cover the costs associated with the administration of the business licensing and monitoring of medical marijuana facilities.

D. Pursuant to NRS 453A.330 the City reserves the right to invoice any medical marijuana facility for its time and materials in administering the provisions of City Code applicable to medical marijuana facilities, as provided in NRS 453A.330.


