

council or may place items for discussion and/or action on the agenda himself.

2. Nevada League Of Cities: In conjunction with at least one member of the city council and/or the city clerk, represent the city on the Nevada league of cities, and either personally or through a duly appointed designee, attend all regularly scheduled functions and meetings of the Nevada league of cities and report to the city council on the current activities, plans, needs, etc., of the Nevada league of cities.

3. Additional Executive Duties: Perform such other executive duties as shall be required by the city council from time to time as the council shall prescribe by ordinance. (Ord. 539, 12-21-1999)

1-5-3:       **MAYOR PRO TEM:** The city council shall elect one of its number to act as mayor pro tem, who shall so act during the temporary absence or disability of the mayor. The mayor pro tem shall possess the powers and duties of mayor when so acting. (Ord. 539, 12-21-1999)

1-5-4:       **CITY COUNCIL<sup>1</sup>:**

- A.    Legislative Body: The city council shall constitute the legislative body of the city.
- B.    Powers: The council shall have the power to make and pass all ordinances, resolutions and orders, not repugnant to the constitutions of the United States or of the state of Nevada or to the provisions of chapter 266 Nevada Revised Statutes, necessary for good municipal government and the management of the city affairs, for the execution of all powers vested in the city.
- C.    Additional Powers: The city council shall further possess all powers expressly set forth in chapters 266 and 268 of the Nevada Revised Statutes pertaining to city council authority. (Ord. 539, 12-21-1999)
